

FAILURE TO DO SO SHALL RESULT IN A LATE FEE OF NOT LESS THAN 20 PERCENT OF DOLLARS, PAYABLE BY THE SOLEMNIZING PERSON OR PARTY, AN ADDITIONAL FIVE-DOLLAR LATE FEE MAY BE ASSESSED FOR EACH ADDITIONAL DAY OF FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE FORWARDING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION (1) UP TO A MAXIMUM OF FIFTY DOLLARS FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING WHETHER A LATE FEE SHALL BE ASSESSED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (1). Notes:

1. Descriptive location of the ceremony, could include city. Examples: "Cheyenne County Courthouse", "Chapel of our Savior, Limon" or "Along the San Miguel River in Telluride".
2. Signature of Minister, Pastor, Priest or other legal officiating party.
 For self-solemnized ceremonies: Officiating Party signature line should include signatures of bride and groom, it should not be left blank. Officiating Party Title can be left blank or could include a statement such as, "A loving couple," "Bride and Groom," "pro se" or "Self-Solemnized."
